Recreational Opportunities



HIKING: 3.5 miles of trails

The trails explore the riverine habitats of the south side of the river island.

FISHING: The Susquehanna River has warmwater and coldwater fishing. Common species are smallmouth bass, panfish, and catfish.

Pennsylvania Fish and Boat Commission regulations and laws apply.

PICNICKING: There are picnic tables, drinking water, charcoal grills, and restrooms. Please leave charcoal in grill. Park will remove it later.

BOATING: unlimited hp motors permitted

A boat launch is on the east side of the island. River elevations vary with the seasons and generally are not deep enough for large watercraft.

Motorboats must display a boat registration from any state. Non-powered boats must display one of the following: boat registration from any state; launch permit or mooring permit from Pennsylvania State Parks, available at most state park offices; launch use permit from the Pennsylvania Fish and Boat Commission.

RECREATION FIELDS: Soccer fields are popular attractions for local clubs and the public.
