PRINTING INSTRUCTIONS

This zip file contains three plates:

Plate 1—This large-format plate will require a plotter. It should be printed at 16 inches by 20 inches. If it is printed at this size, the scale will be 1:6,540.

Plate 2—This color plate should be printed at 8.5 inches by 11 inches. If printed at this size, the scale will be 1:12,480.

Plate 3—This black and white plate should be printed at 8.5 inches by 11 inches. If printed at this size, the scale will be 1:12,480.

These maps are provided "as is," and the user assumes the entire risk as to their quality and performance. These lake maps are not designed for navigation. They are designed to assist boaters and anglers. Lake depth may change due to drawdown, flooding, and siltation. Fallen trees and other debris may move. Please be aware of your surroundings at all times, and follow all commonwealth fishing and boating rules.

It is important to note that water depths are recorded for the normal pool level of the lake. Users should locate the lake-level gage, often at the spillway, to be confident the lake is at normal pool, as drawdown or flooding events will obviously change the water depth.
