Additional Information

Nockamixon Lake: Swimming in the lake is prohibited at all times.

First Aid: See a lifeguard in the lifeguard station for help.

Lost and Found: Drop off found items or look for lost items at the lifeguard station.

Access for People with Disabilities: An ADA accessible ramp at the ticket booth area leads down to the main pool complex. The shallow end of the pool is zero-depth entry. A wheelchair lift is also available. If you need an accommodation to participate in park activities due to a disability, please contact the park office.

Inclement Weather

The pool is open rain or shine except during thunderstorms.

Thunderstorm Protocol:

- At the first sign of lightning or thunder, lifeguards will immediately clear all people from the pool and the pool area. Swimmers should seek shelter during the storm.
- A hand stamp is needed to reenter the pool after the storm.
- No new admission will be sold until the pool is reopened.
- The pool will reopen 30 minutes after the last visible or audible sign of the storm.
- If the pool is closed due to a thunderstorm, no refund will be issued.

2021 Swimming Pool Policies & Information



Pool Rules

These rules and regulations are designed to ensure the safety of all patrons of this facility. A complete listing of park rules and regulations can be obtained at the park office or bulletin boards throughout the park.

Lifeguards must be obeyed at all times.

Swimming Attire: Pool patrons must wear appropriate attire.

The following are prohibited:

- Street clothes and cut-off pants
- Any swimsuit that does not cover the male or female pubic area, female breast, or the buttocks.
- Clothing that is not leak-proof on a child who is not toilet-trained. Regular diapers are prohibited in the pool. Swim diapers are for sale at the concession stand.

Food, Drinks, and Coolers: All food and drinks must be purchased and consumed at the concession stand patio. Outside coolers, beverages, and food are prohibited in this facility, except bottled water and baby formula. Lifeguards, park rangers, and ticket booth staff will confiscate any food outside the concession area.

Supervising Children: Parents and counselors must adequately monitor their family or group. **Children 10 years of age and younger must be supervised by a responsible person 14 years of age or older.** No person shall supervise more than 5 children. Any group not in compliance can be required to leave without refund.

Smoking: Smoking is prohibited inside the fenced-in pool area. Cigarettes, pipes, cigars, e-cigarettes, vaporizers/vape devices, and other handheld lighted smoking devices are only permitted outside the complex gates. A cigarette butt disposal bin is available near the pool entrance.

Pets: Pets are prohibited in the pool area.

Swimming Gear: Most floatation equipment is permitted in the swimming pool, including pool noodles, water wings, floatation vests, PFDs, and inner tubes. Goggles and face masks are permitted. Snorkels, swim fins, and SCUBA equipment are prohibited.

Prohibited Activities within Fenced Pool Area:

- Running
- Prolonged breath holding
- Diving or any headfirst entry into the water
- Horseplay, dunking, sitting on people's shoulders, or hanging on the ropes
- Using profanity or obscene/offensive language
- Playing loud music

Pool Information

The whale-shaped pool contains 550,000 gallons of water. Depth ranges from 0-5 feet. Several spray features are in the zero-depth entry area of the pool.

Waterslides: Two 8 ft. tall waterslides are available for swimmers that can meet one or more of the following requirements:

- Stand in the waterslide area with their head out of the water
- Swim across the width of the pool
- Pass a swim test upon request of a lifeguard

Admission Policies

Your entry into the pool complex signifies that you understand and agree to comply with all the pool rules. Violation of any of the rules may result in your removal from the pool complex without refund.

Hand Stamping: A hand stamp system is used to allow people to leave and re-enter the pool area easily. The stamp is available at the exit window as you leave.

If you wish to reenter the pool area, ask for a stamp. The stamp is not waterproof nor permanent. You are responsible for maintaining a visible stamp. If the stamp begins to fade, ask for another stamp.

Admission will be denied if:

- Your hand stamp is not visible.
- Your hand stamp has been transferred to someone else or if you received a transferred hand stamp.
- Lifeguards or park staff required you leave the pool area.
- Children under the age of 10 are not accompanied by a responsible adult. Always accompany children through the gate to prevent them from becoming stuck inside or outside the pool gate.
- Carrying food, drinks, or coolers.
- You have a pet.
- The pool reaches capacity. Once capacity is reached, only patrons with valid hand stamps will be admitted.

If the pool closes for any reason, refunds will not be issued.

Admission Rates

Ticket booth admission is cash only.

Credit card transactions may be made at the park office during normal business hours.

Admission:

Valid Pennsylvania ID must be shown to receive the PA Resident admission rate. Maximum 5 person admission per ID. Those without a PA ID will be charged the higher admission rate.

Children under 42" are free everyday.

Weekdays have the most affordable admission rates. Weekend and holiday rates are higher.

Discounts:

- Seniors age 62 and older
- Cabin occupants with receipt
- Late arrival (after 4:00 PM)

Season Passes are available for purchase at the park office:

- Individuals
- Seniors (age 62+)
- Family (up to 5 people living in one household)
 - Additional child (for families with more than 5 people)

Organized Groups:

At the park office, organized groups may purchase a book of 20 tickets for a discounted rate.

Chairs:

Chairs may also be rented in the pool area for a fee.
