PENNSYLVANIA OUTDOOR CORPS ADULT CREW MEMBERS NEEDED

The SCA, in partnership with the Pennsylvania Department of Conservation and Natural Resources (DCNR), is seeking Crew Members to join the Pennsylvania Outdoor Corps. The Pennsylvania Outdoor Corps offers paid work experience, job training, and educational opportunities to members as they protect and restore public lands and waters.

PA Outdoor Corps members will join a team of six to complete conservation projects on Pennsylvania's public lands. Projects include, but are not limited to: general trail maintenance, habitat restoration, vegetation management, facility maintenance and light construction. Throughout the season members participate in education and training activities related to resource management, environmental topics and recreation skills. Candidates should have an interest in pursuing careers with state agencies. Most work and activities take place outdoors in all seasons and weather and involve physically demanding labor.

POSITION DETAILS

Altoona, Meadville, Harrisburg, Harrisburg (Roving Resource Management), Pittsburgh, Philadelphia (Roving Trail Crew), Wilkes-Barre, Williamsport, and Saint Marys
- Position Dates: March 1st – December 3rd, 2021
- Weekly Schedule: Monday - Thursday, 7:00 AM - 5:00 PM
Roving Crews Schedule: Wed-Wed (8 days on with 6 days off)
- Compensation: \$13.20/hour, employer-sponsored benefits, paid trainings and career-development opportunities
- **Application Deadline:** Jan 1, 2021. We will not be making selections until after Jan 1

QUALIFICATIONS:

- Ages 18 - 25 at the start of the position
- Able to conduct manual work in all outdoor conditions. Including the ability to hike up to 4 miles per day
- Interest in careers with DCNR or other governmental agencies in conservation or natural resource management
- Willing to complete Camping Hitches during the season, spending up to a week away from home. (Necessary gear provided)
- Able to model safe and professional behavior at all times.
- Have or secure housing in or near the program city.
