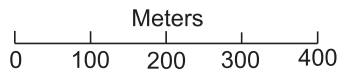

- Old Navigation Marker

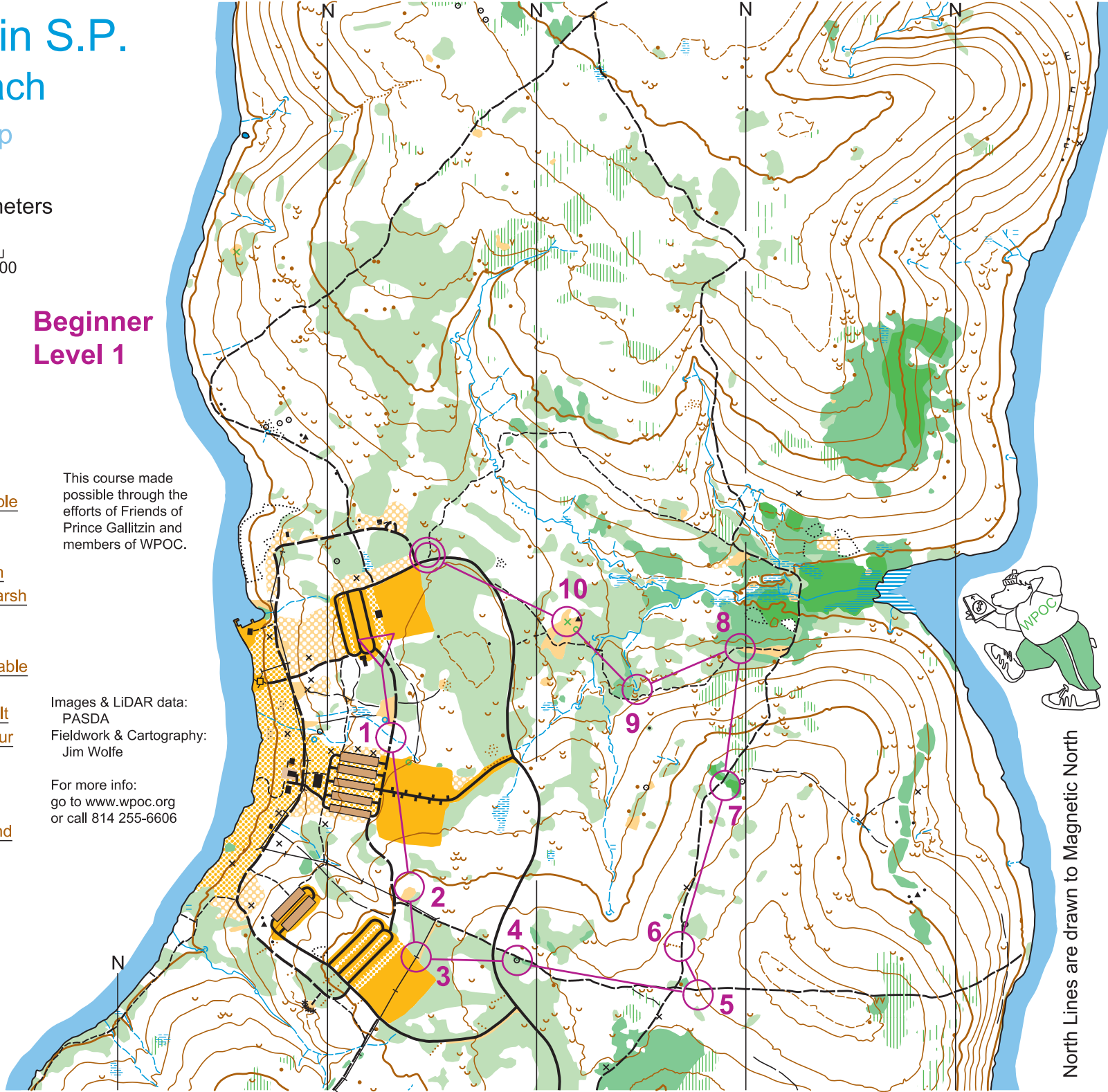
