

Things to Do in the Park

- Paddle a kayak through the remote areas of Killbuck, Mud Lick, Wyerough or Slate Lick coves.
- Catch a glimpse of a Bald Eagle while bird watching.
- Walk along Gibbons Road at dusk and enjoy a beautiful sunset.
- Stop into our Campground Store for a hand-dipped ice cream cone.
- Enjoy picnicking with your group, or spend the night in our campground.
- Join the park naturalists for educational presentations or recreational programs.
- Spend the day boating and fishing on the 1,635 acre Glendale Lake.
- Take in the scenic views from the Headache Hill water tower or stop at the Mud Lick Gazebo.
- Enjoy 32 miles of trails to explore the woods of the Allegheny Plateau.
- Visit Muskrat Beach to cool off in the clear water or relax along the lake shore.



Prince Gallitzin State Park

At Prince Gallitzin State Park, the forested hills of the Allegheny Plateau cradle sprawling Glendale Lake. Vistas offer scenic views of the 1,635-acre lake with its 26 miles of shoreline, which is a favorite of anglers and boaters. Campers flock to the large campground and also enjoy hiking and other outdoor activities. The varied habitats of the park make it a home for many types of wildlife, and a rest stop in the spring and fall for migrating birds.

Facilities Available to Rent

Pavilion #1 - Pickerel Pond Access



Located at the Pickerel Pond Access, Pavilion #1 has electricity, two charcoal grills, a water spigot, nearby modern restrooms and a nearby children's playground.

Pavilion #2 - Muskrat Beach Access, Area 2



Located in Muskrat Beach Area 2, this pavilion is in close proximity to our swimming area. Attached restroom with showers are available, as well as electricity, a water spigot, charcoal grills, and is near a children's playground.

Pavilion #3 - Muskrat Beach Access, Area 3



Pavilion #3 is found in Muskrat Beach Area 3, alongside a large open field perfect for sports and games. This pavilion has a nearby restroom and the swimming beach is a short walk away. No electricity is available at this facility.

Pavilion #4 - Muskrat Beach Access, Area 3



Also located at Muskrat Beach Area 3, this pavilion offers electricity and on-site Restrooms and showers. A charcoal grill is included and the swimming beach is nearby.

Prince Gallitzin Pavilion - Gibbons Road Access



Our newest pavilion overlooks the lake at the Prince Gallitzin Marina. There are restrooms and water available at the Marina Concession. There is also a charcoal grill.

Mud Lick Gazebo - Mud Lick Overlook



A perfect spot for a wedding, the Mud Lick arm of our lake offers the fantastic backdrop for your day.
