





STANDING STONE TRAIL

Stretching 84 miles through Fulton, Huntingdon, and Mifflin counties, the Standing Stone Trail traverses central Pennsylvania ridges and valleys from Cowans Gap State Park in the south to Rothrock State Forest's Detweiler Run Natural Area and the Mid State Trail in the north. The trail is part of the 1,650-mile Great Eastern Trail, which starts at the Florida-Alabama state line and extends to the Finger Lakes Trail in New York. The Standing Stone Trail Club is dedicated to the preservation, maintenance, and enjoyment of this footpath. For more information visit www.standingstonetrail.org.
