

# Hunter Run Mountain Bike Trail

This area contains several miles of maintained trails designed for low-density recreation. The mountain bike trails are marked with red painted rectangles.

Cornplanter State Forest provides a unique opportunity for dispersed, low-density recreation. A goal of the Bureau of Forestry is to minimize conflicts among state forest users and to ensure that natural resources will be managed in an environmentally sound manner—now and into the future.

The Hunter Run Mountain Bike Trail offers opportunities for mountain bikers on a nested loop system approximately 10 miles in length. This type of trail system allows users to choose to follow small loops or larger loops depending on their abilities and interests. Please keep in mind that the trail system is open to other non-motorized uses including hiking, and cross-country skiing and snow-shoeing when snow cover is adequate. All of the trails are rated as easy to more difficult.



# Cornplanter State Forest

Cornplanter State Forest, located in Forest, Crawford and Warren Counties is a valuable part of Pennsylvania’s 17 million acres of forestland. It is named in honor of Chief Corn-planter, a famous Native-American Chief of the Seneca Tribe.

Cornplanter State Forest contains about 1,585 acres. State forests provide clean water, recreation, habitat for plants and animals, places to enjoy tranquility, and high-value timber.
