Sideling Hill Cross Country Ski Trail

The Sideling Hill Cross-country Ski Trail is a system of interconnecting loops totaling 4 miles. The trail system utilizes old logging roads and trails that offer gentle curves and hills. There are varying levels of difficulty on this trail due to terrain.

Cross-country skiing is the primary use on this trail system but it is also open to hiking, mountain biking, and equestrian use.

Note: The western loop of this trail is also joint use with snowmobiles.

The trail is marked with blue 2 x 6 inch rectangles. The trails shown on this map are also marked with numbered reference points at trail intersections that correspond to the numbers identified on the map.
