This zip file contains three plates:

Plate 1—This large-format plate should be printed at 11 inches by 17 inches. If it is printed at this size, the scale will be 1:1,500.

Plate 2—This color plate should be printed at 8.5 inches by 11 inches. If printed at this size, the scale will be 1:2,280.

Plate 3—This black and white plate should be printed at 8.5 inches by 11 inches. If printed at this size, the scale will be 1:2,280.
