Motorized camping, commonly referred to as "car camping" or "roadside camping", is defined as overnight camping in or near a vehicle where the vehicle is used for storage or transportation.

Keep in mind there are no modern conveniences on state forest land such as dump stations, utility hook-ups, showers, trash disposal, or water.

Sproul State Forest offers nine designated motorized campsites which are set aside for RVs only, no tent camping. Self-contained toilets are required.

The nine designated motorized campsites may be reserved up to 90 days in advance. See the Interactive Pa. State Forest Camping Sites Map to check availability and apply for a camping permit.

Permit requests are processed in the order received and time permitting.

Submitting an application does not guarantee the availability of the site or right to camp. A permit must be issued by the forest district.
