

Pennsylvania's vast state forest system comprises 2.2 million acres for you to use, enjoy, and explore. The Department of Conservation and Natural Resources Bureau of Forestry manages these forests to ensure their long-term health and to conserve native wild plants.

Buchanan State Forest is 72,282 acres in Bedford, Fulton, and Franklin counties. The Bear Valley Division has 17,298 acres in Franklin and Fulton counties.

Bear Valley Insights

Bear Valley Division hosts 16 miles of public roads, 83 miles of multi-use trails, 28 miles of hiking only trails including parts of the Tuscarora Trail and the Standing Stone Trail, 19 miles of snowmobile trail, and 17 camp sites

Most of the forest was cut in the late 1800 to early 1900's for charcoal to fuel the nearby iron furnaces. The forest remnants were then harvested for lumber and the land was then sold to the commonwealth. The infrastructure in this area, including most of the roads, bridges, and trails as well as Bear Valley Picnic Area and Cowans Gap State Park were due to the efforts of the Civilian Conservation Corp (CCC). This division hosted two CCC Camps: S-109 Company 1325 and S-54 Company 305. This division is critical to several drinking water supplies and contains a complex of vernal pools that provide critical habitat for a variety of amphibious species.

Care for the Land

State forests belong to all Pennsylvanians. Take time to enjoy them, but know the rules and regulations designed to protect the forests and you. Please be careful with fire, keep our forests litter free, and don't damage trees or other plants.

Leave No Trace

Buchanan State Forest is managed on a leave no trace philosophy. Anything you carry in to use while camping and recreating must be carried back out with you. Depositing any refuse on state forest lands is prohibited.

All field privies (individual use or slit trench latrines) must be at least 200 feet from a lake, stream, spring, or other open water source. Self-contained portable toilets are encouraged and may be required to be used at some designated dispersed campsites.

Wash yourself, your dishes, and your clothes using a container. Washing in a spring, lake or waterway is prohibited.

When camping with horses, refrain from tying horses directly to trees. All horse manure must be removed from the campsite.

Campfire Policy & Safety

Campfires are permitted inside a non-combustible fire ring less than two feet round, and in fire rings or fireplaces provided by the Department EXCEPT when the fire danger is high, very high or extreme, and from March 1 through May 25.

Fires must always be attended. A small breeze can spread fire quickly, so there should be at least one set of eyes monitoring the fire at all times.

Put your fire OUT COLD. If it is too hot to touch, then it is too hot to leave. You assume the liability for damages, extinction costs, fines, and can face criminal charges if you cause a wildfire.

Only downed and dead wood within the immediate campsite may be gathered for firewood. Collect only the amount needed for your stay. Power saws are not permitted without a Fuelwood Permit.

Only use firewood that you gather or purchase locally. Do not take firewood with you. Help save our forests from devastating insects.

Camping in the Buchanan State Forest - Bear Valley Designated Campsites

Buchanan State Forest offers free primitive backpack camping for thru hikers and prepaid reservations for dispersed roadside and roadside hike in camp sites. Camping permits have a \$6.50 transaction fee plus \$15/night, or \$10/night for Pennsylvania residents. There are no modern facilities, water, dump stations or utility hook-ups on state forest lands but these sites offer the opportunity to experience unique ecosystems, wild landscapes, plus the peace and beauty of nature. Dispersed sites are designated by numbered posts scattered through the three maintenance divisions/loops: Bear Valley, Sideling Hill, and Chaneysville. Sites can be reserved by anyone 18+ for up to 7 days. Reservations can be made 11 months in advance to 12 noon on day of arrival. Groups over 10 must obtain a letter of authorization. Check-in and Check-out time is 3:00 pm.
