

#### PENNSYVANIA WILD PLANT SANCTUARIES

Most of Pennsylvania's threatened and endangered plants and animals are found on privately owned land. The Department of Conservation and Natural Resources created the Wild Plant Sanctuary Program to formally commend private land owners for conserving and enhancing native wild plants and communities.

#### **Program Goals:**

- Raise awareness and educate about the important role wild plants play in Pennsylvania while providing information to help conserve native wild plants;
- Establish a voluntary statewide network of Wild Plant Sanctuaries on private lands;
- Recognize, inform, and provide technical assistance to landowners whose properties support habitats and wild plant species of statewide or local significance;
- Encourage and recognize good stewardship practices (including scientifically-sound ecological restoration) for native habitats and wild plant species;
- Provide natural reserves for native wild plant species that would be made available for research and education.

## Properties will be considered for the Wild Plant Sanctuary Program if they contain one or more of the following:

- ✓ Plants that are rare, threatened, or endangered in Pennsylvania
- ✓ Host plants for rare moths, butterflies, and other arthropods
- ✓ Outstanding or unique natural features or plant communities
- ✓ Exceptional management practices (e.g., restoring a rare plant community using local genetic material)

#### Areas NOT considered appropriate for Wild Plant Sanctuaries include:

- Formal gardens or landscaping with "improved" nursery stock of state-listed plant species
- Sites restored using plants or seeds from sources outside Pennsylvania or of unknown origin
- Properties threatened by future development, poor management practices, or unmanageable invasive plant infestations

Attached is an application for Wild Plant Sanctuary designation. Applications are accepted throughout the year. Applicants can expect a response from the Wild Plant Sanctuary Committee within about six months from the time the application is submitted.
