



## Pinchot State Forest Recreation Area Rules

Pinchot State Forest is managed on a **leave no trace** philosophy that is a **CARRY IN, CARRY OUT** approach. Depositing any refuse on State Forest Lands is prohibited. You are responsible to remove and properly dispose of any refuse or trash from your stay.

- Camping is prohibited, except in designated campsites with a valid camping permit.
- Construction of new trails, without the authorization of the District Forester is prohibited.
- Visitors shall park only in designated parking areas.
- The use of chainsaws is prohibited.
- Fires are limited to the metal fire rings located at the campsites and pavilions.
- Removal or destruction of tables, fireplaces or any other Commonwealth property is prohibited.
- The discharge of firearms, fireworks, and explosives is prohibited.
- Hunting within Camping and Recreation Areas is prohibited.
- Damaging any tree or shrub is prohibited.
- All other DCMR Bureau of Forestry Rules and Regulations – Title 17. Pennsylvania Code, Part I. Department of Conservation and Natural Resources, Subpart C. State Forests, Chapter 21. General Provisions - apply within Pinchot State Forest Recreation Area and Camping Area.
