

Pinchot State Forest Recreation Area Rules

<u>Pinchot State Forest is managed on a leave no trace philosophy that is a CARRY</u> <u>IN, CARRY OUT approach. Depositing any refuse on State Forest Lands is</u> <u>prohibited. You are responsible to remove and properly dispose of any refuse or</u> trash from your stay.

- Camping is prohibited, except in designated campsites with a valid camping permit.
- Construction of new trails, without the authorization of the District Forester is prohibited.
- Visitors shall park only in designated parking areas.
- The use of chainsaws is prohibited.
- Fires are limited to the metal fire rings located at the campsites and pavilions.
- Removal or destruction of tables, fireplaces or any other Commonwealth property is prohibited.
- The discharge of firearms, fireworks, and explosives is prohibited.
- Hunting within Camping and Recreation Areas is prohibited.
- Damaging any tree or shrub is prohibited.
- All other DCNR Bureau of Forestry Rules and Regulations Title 17. Pennsylvania Code, Part I. Department of Conservation and Natural Resources, Subpart C. State Forests, Chapter 21. General Provisions apply within Pinchot State Forest Recreation Area and Camping Area.
