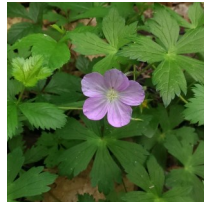

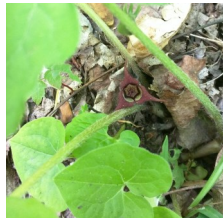

- If you become lost: stop, stay calm, stay put, and dial 911. The further you walk the longer it will take to find you.

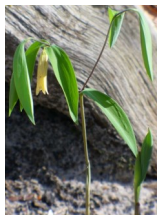

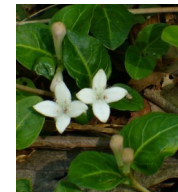
