

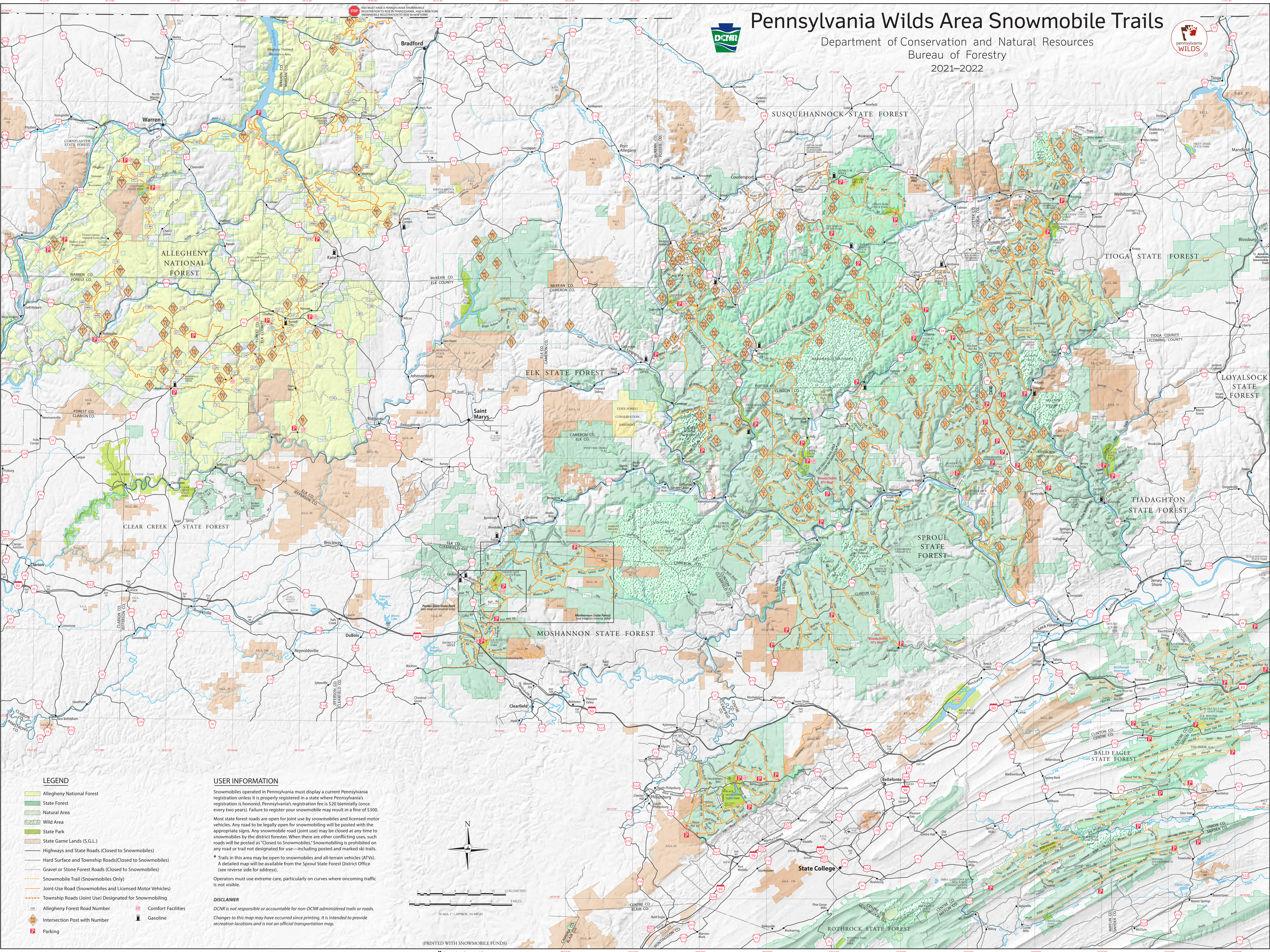


Pennsylvania Wilds Area Snowmobile Trails

USER INFORMATION

Snowmobiles operated in Pennsylvania must display a current Pennsylvania registration unless it is properly registered in a state where Pennsylvania's registration is honored. Pennsylvania's registration fee is \$20 biennially (once every two years). Failure to register your snowmobile may result in a fine of \$300.

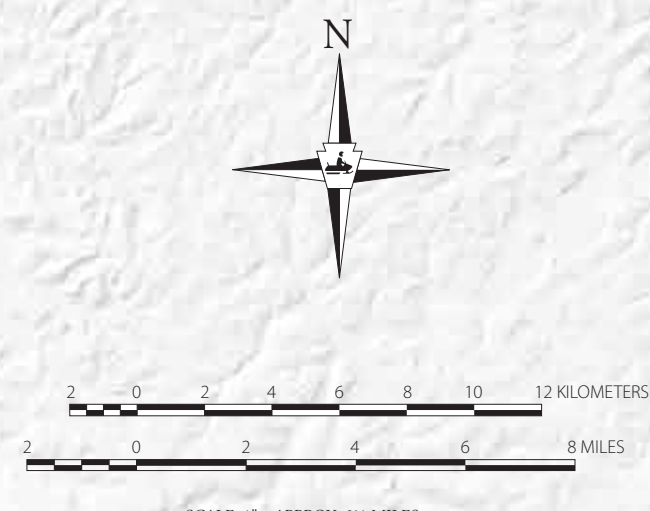
Most state forest roads are open for joint use by snowmobiles and licensed motor vehicles. Any road to be legally open for snowmobiling will be posted with the appropriate signs. Any snowmobile road (joint use) may be closed at any time to snowmobiles by the district forester. When there are other conflicting uses, such roads will be posted as "Closed to Snowmobiles." Snowmobiling is prohibited on any road or trail not designated for use—including posted and marked ski trails.

* Trails in this area may be open to snowmobiles and all-terrain vehicles (ATVs). A detailed map will be available from the Sproul State Forest District Office (see reverse side for address).

Operators must use extreme care, particularly on curves where oncoming traffic is not visible.
