## **Moosic Mountain Tract**

The Moosic Mountain Tract includes a combined total of over 2,000 acres of forest land lying east of the town of Olyphant in northern Lackawanna County.

This tract of state forest is also surrounded by a substantial amount of state game lands and both offer excellent hunting opportunities. Additionally, The Moosic Mountain Barrens can be found on the nearby Dick and Nancy Eales Preserve, which is also open for public recreation and includes many trails.

## **Pinchot State Forest**

The Pinchot State Forest is named in honor former PA governor and state forester Gifford Pinchot, who was a visionary of forest management. The Pinchot State Forest is an essential part of the acclaimed Pocono Mountain region of northeast Pennsylvania.
