The Bureau of Forestry manages the timber on state forestland on a sustainable basis. It is sometimes necessary to put in regeneration cuts in order to regenerate hardwood forests.

Regeneration cuts remove almost all of the trees in a stand in order to let sunlight to the forest floor in order to stimulate the growth of species that thrive in sunlight, like oak, ash, cherry, and poplar.

Within a few years, these cuts produce excellent brushy wildlife habitat. When mature, these tree species are extremely valuable to wildlife.

### Estimated height growth of new trees:

0-10 yr old cut → 0-10 ft tall trees

11-20 yr old cut → 11-20 ft tall trees

21-30 yr old cut → 21-30 ft tall trees



13 yr old clearcut

All of the Forbes State Forest is open to public hunting, except designated State Forest Picnic Areas and any other areas posted closed to hunting.

Please hunt safely and abide by all the current Pennsylvania Game Laws. Enjoy hunting on the Forbes State Forest.
